
Larry Kramer Class of 1981



2022 Hall of Fame Inductee 3-Year Basketball & Baseball Starter (1979-1981)

Larry Kramer was a three-year starter in both basketball and baseball from 1979 to 1981. Basketball was the sport where he earned the majority of his accolades. Kramer currently is 11th in school history with 1000 career points. As a senior, he led the 1980-81 Panther basketball team to a 19-5 record and one win away from the state tournament, losing to eventual state champion Paullina in the sub-state title game. He averaged 18.8 points per game as a senior for a total of 450 points on the season. As a result, he earned 1st Team All-Quad County Conference, 3rd Team All-Northwest Iowa, and Honorable Mention All-Class, All-State recognition, and 1st Team All-Area selected by the Storm Lake *Pilot-Tribune*.

Kramer scored 283 points as a junior, good for 20th most all-time by a junior, and earning 1st Team All-Area recognition again by the *Pilot Tribune* and 2nd Team All-Quad County Conference honors. He scored 260 points in 10th grade, good for 10th most by a sophomore and earning him 2nd Team All-Quad County Conference recognition.

As a second baseman in baseball, Larry was one of the team's top hitters and helped the Panthers to excellent seasons as a junior and senior, winning sectional titles both years, as well as a district title and sub-state appearance in 1981, falling one win away from a state tournament appearance.

Larry and his wife Wendy live in Grinnell, IA. They have 3 adult children and 7 grandchildren. After working in the Information Technology field for more than 35 years, Larry retired in 2020. The couple now enjoys traveling as much as possible, golfing, and attending sporting events, especially those involving their grandchildren.
