Excellence in Education Award

The Excellence in Education award recipient must be teachers who have been in any of the Catholic schools in the Diocese of Sioux City for five consecutive years or more and remains employed at the time of the 2023 ministries conference when the award is given.

- A nomination from the building principal, president or parish pastor, unless the nomination is for the sole school principal.

The Good Shepherd Award

The Good Shepard award recipient can be any school employee who has been employed in any of the Catholic schools for five consecutive years or more. Previous years' award winners have included school administrators, principals, administrative assistants, custodians etc.

Anyone can nominate another person for either of the two awards. Examples include teachers nominate fellow teachers. PTO organizations nominate school employees, parishioners nominate fellow teachers and/or employees.
